## Tom's Toolbox for Christians at Work "Look Up, Look Out, and Step Up"

One of the Webster Christmas traditions is to go see a movie as a family. This year we chose "Rogue One", a Star Wars film that is a prequel of the original Star Wars movie that came out in 1977. I enjoyed the show as I have been a Star Wars fan from its beginning.

I will try not to spoil the movie for those who have not yet seen it, but essentially it was about a time of great conflict in the universe. The struggle of good against evil was being fought on a cosmic scale. In that time, a group of unlikely heroes, banded together on a mission to steal the plans to the Death Star, the Empire's ultimate weapon of destruction. This key event in the Star Wars timeline brings together ordinary people who choose to do extraordinary things, and in doing so, become part of something greater than themselves.

A key turn in the plot came when the rebel, Saw, asked the heroin how she can stand not doing something about the injustices of the Empire. She replied, "I just don't look up."
